What does this mean?

### The Eighth Commandment

You shall not give false testimony against your neighbor.

### What does this mean?

We should fear and love God so that we do not tell lies about our neighbor, betray him, slander him, or hurt his reputation; but defend him, speak well of him, and explain everything in the kindest way.
