**The Ten Commandments, LSB 321**

**The Seventh Commandment**

**The Eighth Commandment**

*We should fear and love God so that we do not tell lies about our neighbor,  
 betray him, slander him, or hurt his reputation, but defend him, speak well of  
 him, and explain everything in the kindest way.*
