Learn-By-Heart Catechism...

**The Ten Commandments, LSB 322**

**The Ninth Commandment**

*You shall not covet your neighbor's house.*

**What does this mean?**

*We should fear and love God so that we do not scheme to get our neighbor's  
inheritance or house, or get it in a way which only appears right, but help  
and be of service to him in keeping it.*

**The Tenth Commandment**

*You shall not covet your neighbor's wife, or his manservant or maidservant,  
his ox or donkey, or anything that belongs to your neighbor.*

**What does this mean?**

*We should fear and love God so that we do not entice or force away our  
neighbor's wife, workers, or animals, or turn them against him, but urge  
them to stay and do their duty.*

*O God, our Maker and Redeemer, You wonderfully created us and in the  
incarnation of Your Son yet more wondrously restored our human nature.  
Grant that we may ever be alive in Him who made Himself to be like us; through  
Jesus Christ, our Lord, who lives and reigns with You and the Holy Spirit, one  
God, now and forever. Amen.*
